Eritrean community members in Heppenheim city extend material support to the ENWVA

Asmara, 6 February 2013 – Eritrean community members residing in the German city of Heppenheim have extended bicycles and wheelchairs to the Eritrean National War-disabled Veterans Association (ENWVA). Reports indicated that the role of the Association's branch in the city was praiseworthy in the process vis-à-vis that of the branch offices of the NUEW and NUEYS.
